SHERIFF'S HOMICIDE DETECTIVES ARE CONTINUING THEIR INVESTIGATION INTO THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DEPUTY INVOLVED SHOOTING.

HOMICIDE DETECTIVES HAVE LEARNED THAT DEPUTIES ASSIGNED TO COMPTON SHERIFF'S STATION ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE SUSPECT, A MALE BLACK ADULT. WHEN THEY APPROACHED THE SUSPECT HE TURNED TOWARD THEM AND IMMEDIATELY STARTED RUNNING AND JUMPED OVER A FENCE INTO A RESIDENCE. THE DEPUTIES FOLLOWED AND AS THE SUSPECT WAS JUMPING OVER A CHAIN LINK FENCE HOLDING HIS WAISTBAND IN FRONT OF ONE OF THE DEPUTIES HE WAS ORDERED TO SHOW HIS HANDS. THE SUSPECT LOOKED AT THE DEPUTY AND STARTED TO TURN TOWARD HIM. FEARING FOR HIS SAFETY, THE DEPUTY FIRED HIS DUTY WEAPON AT THE SUSPECT STRIKING HIM.

THE SUSPECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WHERE HE WAS PRONOUNCED DEAD.

NO DEPUTIES WERE INJURED.
