The team sergeant meets regularly with city officials and coordinates with them on handling traffic related complaints. The team is responsible for assisting with crosswalk operations, drunk driving checkpoints as well as the movement of traffic at city events.

IZELL	(626) 292-3395	templestationcrimetips@lasd.org	<p>Teen drivers who display poor or unsafe driving habits increase the likelihood of a serious traffic collision. The consequences of such a collision may result in costly property damage and personal injury or even death.</p> <p>In an effort to bring the reality of unsafe driving to our teen drivers, we have implemented S.T.T.O.P. This program relies on our citizens to report unsafe teen drivers to our specialized hotline. After receiving the report of unsafe driving, we contact the driver and explain the dangers of unsafe driving.</p> <p>When a member of the community observes a teenage driver operating a motor vehicle in a dangerous or reckless manner, their driving may be reported by calling the S.T.T.O.P. Hotline at (626) 292-3395. Please provide the vehicle's license plate number, vehicle color, and driver's description.</p> <p>The S.T.T.O.P. program does not dispatch a deputy sheriff to take immediate law enforcement action. Rather, with the information left by the anonymous caller, a deputy conducts an "intervention" with the teenaged driver and his/her parent(s). The counseling session is designed to create positive change in the driving habits of our teenagers.</p>

Any member of the public can call the toll free hotline @877-310-7867. Here, they are able to leave a message regarding the type of reckless driving they witnessed, where and when it took place, and a description of the vehicle(s), including license plate numbers.</p> <p>The STOPP Deputy at Santa Clarita Station checks these messages routinely, and follows up on all complaints. If a license plate is provided, or the driver can be identified by other means, the STOPP Deputy will contact that person. The deputy will then schedule a meeting with the offender and his/her parents to conduct an intervention.</p>
