**Synopsis:** Community Emergency Response Team's (CERT) are formed by members of a neighborhood or work place who want to be better prepared for the hazards that threaten their communities.

Initially, CERT programs were developed to assist communities in taking care of themselves in the aftermath of a major disaster when first responders are overwhelmed or unable to respond because of communication or transportation difficulties. As the CERT concept has taken hold across the country, however, CERT's have become much more than originally envisioned. CERT's have proven themselves to be an active and vital part of the communities' preparedness and response capability. For example, CERT's have been used to:

- \* Distribute and/or install smoke detectors and batteries to the elderly and/or disabled
- \* Assist with evacuations and traffic control
- \* Promote community awareness of potential hazards and preparedness measures
- \* Supplement staffing at special events such as parades
- \* Act as victims in training exercises

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program is an all-risk, all-hazard training. This valuable course is designed to help citizens protect themselves, their family, their neighbors and their neighborhood in an emergency situation.
