Synopsis: The Dock Walk program was created primarily to maintain a liaison between the boating community, the dockmasters and the Sheriffs Department. It is designed to identify and correct safety problems on the docks and to identify unauthorized persons on the docks. Deputies designated to work on the patrol boats are each assigned 2-3 marinas to "walk" (provide foot patrol for) at least once per month. The deputies work closely with the dockmasters to ensure correction of all safety violations which have been noted.
